The project aims to enhance university enterprise cooperation in Jordan and Lebanon in order to improve teaching and learning in partner universities, enhance the employability of graduates and create conditions for applied research cooperation and knowledge transfer between partner universities and enterprises. The general objectives of the project are:

- To stimulate the development of an enterprise cooperation culture at partner universities.
- To promote the sharing of good practice for establishing universitybased Enterprise Liaison Offices, and developing new forms of industryoriented education in a number of Jordanian and Lebanese Universities.
- To improve the ICT curricula and upgrade the capacities of academic and technical staff of partner universities.
- To develop a coherent information and communication strategy for the University communities within the local business environment.
- To develop a programme-strategy to support students to develop their master theses and internships with enterprises to enhance their employability

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Educational Transformation workshop organised by SU at PSUT

28 - 30 November 2022

"Education Transformation: Computer Science and Games Design & Programming" is title of a workshop organized by the UK project partner, Staffordshire University, from November 28th to November 30th, 2022 at Princess Sumaya University for Technology in Amman.

An engaged cohort of twenty-one participants from Jordanian and Lebanese universities was introduced to the skills that are imperative for the development, modernization, and effective delivery of courses in the realms of games design and computer science.

Over the course of these three days, participants immersed themselves in intensive sessions, collaborative dialogues, and hands-on interaction with technology used in the delivery of courses within this area under supervision of five experts from Staffordshire University.

Advanced Topics in AI, Cybersecurity and Big Data Workshop - UNIVPM

06-10 February 2023

The workshop "Advanced Topics in AI, Cybersecurity, and Big Data" was hosted by the Universita Politecnica delle Marche, Ancona, Italy, 6-10 February 2023. This workshop exemplifies our steadfast commitment to advancing academic programs and enriching graduate employability by engaging our academic colleagues in the latest development in their teaching and research fields in conjunction with partner universities in the EU. This workshop consisted of three strands of AI, Cybersecurtiy and Big Data, each led by one of the leading academics in the field, Professors Adriano Mancini, Marco Baldi, and Domenico Potena respectively.

With a twelve dedicated participants this workshop with its three sub-groups, the participants were introduced to the knowledge and skills essential for the development, modernization, and effective delivery of courses encompassing AI, cybersecurity and big data.

Over the course of these five stimulating days, participants delved into intensive sessions on issues at the frontiers of knowledge and research in the three areas, engaged in collaborative discussions, and immersed themselves in practical exercises. They shared best practices, teaching techniques and resources that can be used in classrooms at their home institutions as well as their own research activities. In this way, additional step was made towards the modernization and revision of courses in higher education institutions from Jordan and Lebanon with the aim of enhancing graduate employability.



6-8 December 2023

The Assistant Project Coordinator (Prof Iraj Hashi, Univ of Dubrovnik) and the External Evaluator of the project, Mrs Jenny Herbert made a Monitoring Visit to partner universities in Jordan. The Lebanese partner institutions also attended the main meeting. The project Monitoring Meeting took place on 6 December at PSUT, Amman. Partners discussed the progress of the project and the quality issues at their institutions. Prof Hashi reviewed the overall progress of the project in terms of targets achieved for activities completed as well as the targets for remaining activities. Mrs Jenny Herbert elaborated the issue of the quality of outputs and the impact of the project on partner universities, students, staff and the society at large. On 7th and 8th December, the Assistant Coordianator and the External Evaluator visited Jordan University of Science and Technology and the Al Balqa Applied University. They met groups of participants in the activities of the project and discussed the quality of their experience on various visits and online meetings.

20-21 February 2023

The workshop on Digital Business Tools was organised by UNIDU at both Princess Sumaya University for Technology and Al Balqa Applied University on 20th and 21st February 2023. Five senior Croatian professors, Nebojsa Stojcic, Jurica Pavicic, Božidar Jaković. Zoran Krupka and Goran Vlasic, made a variety of presentations on different applications of recent developments in digital technology to the business fields for staff and PhD students at partner universities in Jordan. They held intensive discussions with participants and exchanged views on the application of digital technologies in the Jordanian context.




Final Project Conference at BAU & MUBS
